## July Principal Report –

- Congratulations to our Senior dance group on their performance at the In the Spotlight Dance festival.
- Our second Fathering Project event - Bangers and Bingo – was another successful afternoon, with over 60 dads and kids in attendance. Thank you to Miss Benita for organising the event, along with the teachers who volunteered. The date and time for the next event TBC. Night event likely.
- Reports will be sent home tomorrow. Class teachers are available if parents need further clarification or would like to discuss the content of the reports.
- Ethics began this month for Stage 1 students. Volunteers required if ethics is to expand into other stages.
- Two students have had artwork selected for the Sutherland Shire Schools Music Festival program. Congratulations Yvette and Ellouise. –
- Staffing- Miss Amos is currently on LSL until the end of the term. Mr Yock will be taking LSL Week 1 next term with Mrs Hitchcock filling in for both classes.
- Term 2 music tutorials finish this week. They will start again in Week 2 Term 3. Parents of students who are currently attending have received an email to state if they are intending to continue. A push alert will go out at the end of this week to any other parents who may like their child to start music lessons in Term 3.
- Staff have updated the student bathrooms with positive affirmations to complement our whole school mindfulness program and PBL expectations.
- We recently received some outdoor tables from a local high school. They are currently being painted and oiled and will be placed around the school for the students to eat their lunch on.
- Noise wall – On track to be completed by the end of the month. LED sign has been moved and a new slab has been poured for our chickens. Staff have already noticed a reduction in noise, particularly in the 3/4 & 5/6 block and on the basketball court.
- Last week we were one of 17 schools in NSW chosen at random to complete a NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) Random Inspection –looking at the curriculum area of the English. Two inspectors visited the school to view teaching and learning programs, assessment and work samples. The inspection resulted in overwhelmingly positive feedback.
