Gratitude Week, Grandparents' Day and Wheels Day. It was great to see so many Grandparents and visitors come along for Grandparents' Day and join in on the dancing and games. Wheels Day was also a big success with part of the day focussing on bike and road safety. Thank you to the staff for organising what was an extremely eventful week.

Volunteer and Parent Helper Thank you lunch will be held next week. Invitations have been sent home.

Our final Kindy transition has now been held. Thank you to our Year 4 students who have now been aligned with a 2020 Kindergarten buddy, and printed a bag tag using the This ongoing program supports students in their transition to school and throughout their first two years of school, promoting a safe, inclusive and connected school culture.

Chaplaincy funding 2020-2022 – We have just been notified that our school will once again receive Federal funding to continue our Chaplaincy/Wellbeing program for a further 3 years. This is fantastic news for our school.

Fathering Project Event– The TPPS Amazing Race was another successful evening, with approximately 50 dads and kids in attendance. Thank you to Miss Benita for organising the event.

Our Recycling Centre is now operational, with the previous school bins now removed. The bins are now categorised as: soft plastics, recycling, paper and card, organics and landfill.
