PARENT ONLINE PAYMENTS

Currently, families have been able to make direct deposits into the school bank accounts for payments owing to the school. With the onset of LMBR (Learning Management and Business Reform) being implemented in schools across NSW in term 3, we now have a new method for parents to make their online payments.

Please note that direct deposits will NO longer be accepted for payments (as of 1 May 2016).

It is now possible for parents to make online payments via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of our school website (www.tarenpointps.nsw.edu.au) by selecting 'Payments' on the tool bar as indicated below. Follow the prompts throughout the process and be sure to complete any information with a green asterix. The form will require you to complete which area the payment is dedicated to. Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sport, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). 'Other' is for items not covered in the previous headings. 'Other' can also be used to pay full balances of a school account. You will need to include a description and payment amount in the information boxes that will appear after choosing your category.

To assist you in making your selection, we will include the payment category on the return slip of notes sent home. In the case of the ICAS note sent home today, please select 'Other'.

Your child's details must be entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system.

There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number but these are not used at our school, so please leave them blank.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page, a further receipt will not be issued by the school. Payments must be made by 6pm to ensure they are received the following day.
